

BOB MULCAHY
BASKETBALL COACH
1958-1964

Coach Mulcahy graduated from Lexington Lafayette High School in 1950. His team was the state tournament runner up his junior year and he was named All-Tournament and All-American after the season. Lafayette won the tournament in 1950 and he was again named All-Tournament, All-American and All-State. Mulcahy played college basketball at ECU and was team captain his senior year.

In 1958 he became Seneca's first varsity coach. By 1961 his team was ranked preseason #1 in the state, even though Seneca had yet to graduate its first class! The 1961 team went to state and lost to Ashland, the eventual state champions. The 1962 team lost to St. X in the regional finals and St. X went on to become the state champs in that year.

In 1963 and 1964 his Seneca teams won the State Tournament, he left Seneca with a total record of 142-16 (90%) winning record. Bob was an assistant at Kansas University and then head coach at South Dakota State. He ended his coaching career at his alma mater, ECU.
