Phil Thompson helped lead Seneca to the Kentucky Class AAA State Football Championship with a 10-1 record. He was Seneca's first football All-American end and was highly recruited by many universities throughout the south. Many regard the 1965 football team as the most successful and best ever football team at Seneca.

Phil set school and state records in one season for the most passes caught (53), most receiving yards (796), most yards per catch (15), and most TD passes (9). Seneca was 24-5-1 during his three years as a started at offensive and defensive end. He was coached by former UK player Ron Cain.

Thompson chose to play at Kentucky where he was a wide receiver.
