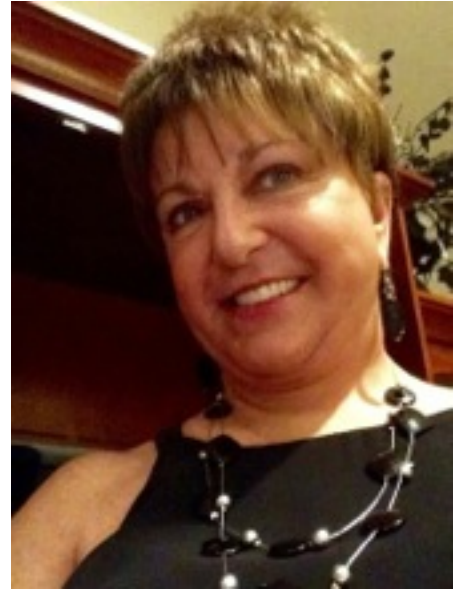


DARLENE WILLIAMS
